Same IP too often

If accounts share an IP, TikTok can easily link them.



Similar Activity

Accounts that show the same actions, like liking or following at the same time, may be flagged as connected.



Shared browser settings

Things like fonts, screen size, and time zone can make accounts seem related.



Cookies

If you use the same browser for different accounts, TikTok can detect that they share cookies.

Pro Tip: To keep your accounts safe, make sure to separate each one properly—
this means using different IPs, browser fingerprints, and cookies for each
account. Isolating your accounts like this helps avoid detection.

How to manage multiple TikTok accounts without getting flagged




IP overlap and shared devices

Problem: If you're using the same IP or device for multiple TikTok accounts, TikTok will catch on pretty quickly. Even switching between browser windows on the same device can raise suspicions.




Identical browser fingerprints

Problem: Your browser gives away a lot of details—things like screen size, fonts, and time zone. When multiple accounts share these details, TikTok can figure out they belong to the same person.

Multilogin Solution: Randomize each account's fingerprint. This changes things like screen size and fonts so TikTok can't tell the accounts are linked.

Result: TikTok sees each account as a different device, so they can't be connected.



Cookie overlap and session data

Problem: Clearing cookies every time or using disposable browsers makes your accounts look brand new every time. TikTok expects to see some history.




